Extended Funding for Vulnerable Children

The <u>Emergency Relief Support fund</u> for children and youth with special needs and their families is being extended until Sept. 30. The fund provides \$225 a month for eligible recipients. Flexible guidelines on autism funding will continue until the end of August and pandemic-related respite funding will be available until March 2021.
